Presentation Formats

- All abstracts are accepted for poster presentations.
- Authors of abstracts accepted for an oral presentation will be notified separately.
- **Free on-site poster printing will be available to all.** Upload your poster in a vector file type (eps or ai) or PDF format by Friday, September 17th at 5:00 PM Eastern Time.
- **Audio narration of your poster.** We recommend filming your presentation in Zoom. PowerPoint is also another option, but not as user friendly. Your presentation should be no longer than 3 minutes in length. Upload the recording by the morning of September 17, 2021, at the latest.
